A total of \$4000.00 in scholarships, awarded in \$1000.00 and \$500.00 increments, will be awarded to High School Seniors who maintained a 2.0 GPA, and are continuing their education after graduation. Scholarships will be used towards a Vocational Tech School or a Career Tech School. Applications will be screened by the Fraternal Order of Eagles #3973 Scholarship Committee. Potential finalists will be contacted and an interview will be scheduled. All finalists must attend the interview for final consideration. Interviews will be conducted the week of May 6th - May 9th, 2019. Scholarship funds will be distributed upon receiving student's verification of enrollment in a post-secondary program as defined above.

Applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

Student must be a senior in a Grossmont Union High School District with anticipation of graduating no later than June 2019.

Student must submit a completed application along with two letters of recommendation from an employer, teacher, school employee, business leader, community leader and/or religious leader. Letters of recommendation must include contact information of the recommender.

Completed application must be postmarked no later than April 30th.
