



Dear IDEA Center Families:

We are looking forward to moving to Level 2 the week of September 28, 2020.

Based on your survey response for Level 2 learning, your student has been assigned to either the Blended Learning Model or to continue in the full Distance Learning Model as described in the GUHSD [Roadmap to Reopening](#). With both options, students are accountable for grades as they would be under normal circumstances.

If you selected the Blended Learning Model, your student has been assigned an attendance group based upon their course schedule, transportation needs, multiple students per household, and other factors. That attendance group determines what day a student will come to campus and which days a student will be a distance learner.

To find your student's group and day of on-campus attendance via the Infinite Campus [Student or Parent Portal](#):

1. Log in
2. Navigate to the Message Center
3. Select the Inbox tab
4. In Inbox, look for a message specifying your student's attendance group

Distance Learning Option	On Campus: N/A Distance: Monday - Friday 100% distance learning
Blended Learning Option (IDEA AC)	On Campus: Tuesday & Thursday Distance: Mon, Wed, Fri
Blended Learning Option (IDEA BD)	On Campus: Wednesday & Friday Distance: Mon, Tue, Thu

Please note that bell schedules have changed this year. To find your student's bell schedule via the Infinite Campus [Student or Parent Portal](#):

1. Log in
2. Navigate to the Schedule tool
3. Scroll to view your student's schedule including period start and end times

Alternatively, you may visit the Parent's section of the [GUHSD web site](#) to view school bell schedules.

As students return to campus, required safety procedures will be in place, including daily temperature checks, face mask requirement for students and staff, physical distancing, and requiring students experiencing COVID-19 symptoms to stay home.
